❖ THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THIS COMPETITION:

1. to give chance for each student to compete at the state level.
2. to elevate the standard of performance of learners of Abacus and Mental Arithmetic.
3. to foster a closer relationship between the Franchisees, Abacus Tutors and Students of various centers.
4. to certify one's capability in Abacus or Mental Arithmetic.
5. to cultivate the habit of attending objective type question paper in their future Academic and Competitive Exams.

❖ QUESTION PAPER PATTERN:

We have prepared common question paper **on A4 Paper Size** for both addition subtraction and multiplication division question section, Student should have to filled carefully all the necessary details like full name, class, seat number, school name etc. on the question paper and use only blue ball pen to write the answers.

SAMPLE QUESTION PAPER:

Academy will provide all the students with 50 sample question papers of each level in A4 Paper size PDF File for practice purpose. Parents need to print back to back on A4 size paper and give it to students for practicing.

❖ MARK FOR ALL LEVEL:

- a) **Elementary / Intermediate / 1st / 2nd Level-** Addition/ Subtraction – 100 Marks
- b) **3rd / 4th / 5th / 6th Level** – Addition / Subtraction – 50 Marks
Multiplication / Division- 50 Marks

The papers are not timed separately. A Single A4 Size back-to-back print papers will be given and marks for all papers will be taken into account for ranking. The students can attempt any paper first that is addition/ subtraction or multiplication / division and then proceed to the next.

❖ ELIGIBILITY:

- a) The competition is open to all students (Private abacus training centers / other academy centers) only as per the eligibility criteria and who are undergoing coaching in any Franchise / School Centre of any state in India.

PARENTS / TEACHER IMPORTANT NOTE:

This exam is an open competition.

Students who appeared for last year's State Level, National Level, or International Level exams can once again appear in this competition in their current running level.

They may attempt the exam in:

- **Their current level, OR**
- **Up to 2 levels above the level, they appeared for in the previous State/ National Level exam.**

All private centre students as well as school project students are eligible to participate. Teachers and parents are requested to take note.

❖ COMPETITION CRITERIA:

- 1) Question and answer sheets of the competition used by the children are the property of **Indian Olympiad** and shall not be distributed after the exam even on request.
- 2) There will be a management of judges from the **Indian Olympiad**.
- 3) In the event of a tie amongst the participants, the management will rank the participants based on accuracy rate wise the attempted sums and / or the highest score in exam will be declared as winner.
- 4) The decision of the management is final and no further correspondences shall be entertained.

- ✚ **Consolation-** candidate will be awarded by consolation Medal & Certificate.
- ✚ **Winners-** 1st /2nd /3rd Ranks winners will be awarded by Winners Medal & Certificate of each level, by the Guest on the day of prize distribution.
- ✚ **Mumbai/ Pune / Chh.Sambhaji Nagar Divison & Other state participants prize distribution program will be done on the same day, 3 hours after completion of the exam.**
- ✚ **Nashik Private Centers Students Winners prize distribution program will be arranging after 15 days of the final result announced.**

❖ GENERAL RULES:

- ✚ Submission of Applications after the deadlines will not be accepted.
- ✚ Students belonging to intermediate & 1st level must bring & use your own **ABACUS TOOL**.
- ✚ For **2nd to 6th level**, usage of Abacus is optional – (With or without Abacus tool).
- ✚ All students must bring the **Hall ticket and Pencil or blue ball Pen** to the competition hall.
- ✚ All students should report at the designated time on the day of the competition.

❖ REPORTING TIME:

Students of any batch should report 30 minutes before the scheduled time of competition at the entry gate announced or as indicated by the teachers.

The detailed exam time table schedule will be provided by the academy **7 days** prior to the competition. Parents can wait outside the competition venue till the end of exam, after end of exam our team will be handover students to parents at the exit gate.
